Summary of the theme and the speakers

## THEME SUMMARY

Digital governance for sustainable development refers to the use of digital technologies to enhance government operations, improve service delivery, and promote transparency, accountability, and citizen engagement. For African administrations, digital governance plays a crucial role in transforming public sector management. It enables more efficient resource allocation, data-driven decision-making and better communication between governments and citizens. In today's rapidly evolving digital world, embracing digital governance is essential for African countries to achieve sustainable development goals, improve public service delivery, and foster economic growth. It helps create more inclusive and transparent systems, addressing challenges such as corruption and inefficient bureaucracy, while promoting long-term societal well-being.



## Key speaker

Dr. Luís Soares Barbosa is the Deputy Director of the United Nations University Operational Unit on Policy-Oriented e-Governance (UNU-EGOV) since 2017. He also coordinates its research line on *Participation*, *People*, and *Communities*. Dr. Barbosa is a Full Professor in the Department of Computer Science at the School of Engineering, University of Minho, and a senior researcher at INESC TEC.

In his role at UNU-EGOV, Dr. Barbosa has been involved in numerous consultancy and development projects with various international institutions such as UNDP, UM ECA, and UNESCO. He was a key member of the teams that developed National Strategies for Digital Governance/Transformation in Cape Verde, São Tomé and Príncipe, and Guinea-Bissau. Recently, he has supported the establishment of Digital Governance Forums in West Africa (Banjul, 2023) and East and South Africa (Pretoria, 2024), promoting a network of countries and international agencies focused on digital governance.
